Eligibility:

Unmasked Hometown Hero nominees serve as an inspiration, serving others during the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic through innovation, caring, support, and strong love for their community. They may be employed in either the business sector or a non-profit organization, students, retirees or work from home. Other criteria include:

- The nominees may be any age - some of the youngest among us have demonstrated great heroics during this time.
- Chamber membership is not required; EXCEPT for nominees who live outside of Monroe County, must be a Chamber member in good standing.
- Nominees may have demonstrated their heroic natures through leadership or service and may have done so professionally or in their personal lives.
